### OUR SERVICES, FEES, PACKAGES

**Workforce Wellness Visits** – On-site stress relief / morale-boosting visits for employees who want to spend a little time with our playfully loving therapy dogs and their human handlers.

## WORKFORCE WELLNESS THERAPY DOG VISITS

**Does Good Dog provide Insurance for the visit?** YES. Each therapy dog-human handler team visiting your office is covered with our liability insurance. Plus, a Certificate of Insurance (COI) naming your building owner provides \$5 million per occurrence and \$6 million in aggregate commercial general liability coverage.

**How do we prepare for a therapy dog visit?** A conference room or other communal space is often the best place for a Good Dog visit. We recommend signing employees up in advance for 10- minute slots, though some prefer longer. Some employees love to get down on the floor with the dogs, while others like sitting in chairs in a circle around a dog and its handler. Our human handlers can enthusiastically share insights about their volunteer therapy dog experiences. IN ADDITION to conference rooms, we do "stop-bys" visiting employees who've requested time with a dog in their cubicles and offices.

**How are the dogs transported to our office space?** Good Dogs always arrive on a leash and remain leashed to their human handler during the entirety of their visit. Our dogs are extremely well-mannered in any environment, easily accommodating to building lobbies, elevators, hallways, loading docks and freight elevators.

**What safeguards are in place to protect our office space?** Our therapy dog-human handler teams work for one hour ONLY per day, which protects the dogs from stressing. All our dogs are groomed and walked prior to visiting your office. They are trained to work with extremely fragile patient populations in hospitals as well as schools, nursing homes, libraries and community centers. The dogs don't relieve themselves until they are out of doors.

**How long do these events usually last?** It depends on the number of employees who want to spend time with a dog. On average, a therapy dog visit experience runs for two hours, with one therapy dog-human handler team per hour.
